

We were able to restore our kitchen and dining and resume serving church dinners. The Sunday School is bursting with excitement as they learn about Jesus and his love. However, despite all our newfound energy, our current expense budget remains in the red.

We started November, negative \$20,556. The Turkey Dinner was a huge success. The Winter Holiday Fund raiser is doing even better than the Fall fund raiser. The Thanksgiving envelopes were more generous this year. Thank you all for your support. But sadly, I must report that we ended the month, \$19,404 in the red.

The sign-up sheet was filled in one Sunday and all the items were delivered on to the Hillsborough Food Pantry in time for distribution. All of this was possible due to your generosity - we all made someone's Christmas a little brighter! Thank you all for making SBRC a wonderful family!

WOMEN'S GROUP

The Women's Group met for the first time in 6 months to clip stamps for the Stamp Alliance Ministry. Please save your stamps. And if you don't have the time and inclination to cut or tear off the stamps, simple turn in the entire envelope, and we'll take care of it. It feels good to get back into the swing of things such as this mission. We would have begun sooner, but the Ministry was shut down for a while because of Hurricane Ian and the devastation that it caused in Ft. Myers where they are located. But all is well now.

River blindness mission giving was \$20.00 for this past month. Many thanks to those who drop in their coins (and sometimes dollars) to the container by the stairs at the entrance to the sanctuary. In addition to providing medicine to prevent river blindness, which they hope to eradicate within the next five years, River Blindness Mission also helps to provide eye surgeries. Dr. Faustin Ngounou operates on cataracts for example: \$39 will provide cataract surgery for an adult; \$200 will provide cataract surgery and anesthesia for a child. Local residents do not have such money, but you can help with your coins and dollar bills. Every little bit helps. When you see loose change lying about, remember the good it can do halfway around the world.
