

WOMEN'S GROUP

Our deepest thanks go to everyone in the congregation who bring in stamps each month. We will still be collecting stamps over the summer months, so be on the lookout. The stamp basket is in the church office on the shelf next to the door. Just drop them in as you walk past on your way to the sanctuary. Hopefully, the basket will be overflowing by the time we return to clipping stamps in September. The Alliance Stamp Ministry where we send out stamps has raised more than \$8,000 to print Sunday School materials in Spanish so far this year. There is a great opportunity in world mission today to reach these children for Jesus. Collecting and sending stamps is just one small way that we can be a part of that outreach. Your stamps could help a child come to know Him.
