FROM THE PASTOR

On September 1, 2021, the effects of Tropical Depression Ida just started to hit our area. The forecasted 3"-5" of rain turned out to be 8' of water in the dining room & kitchen and 4.5' of water down the hallway, preschool office, and other rooms. A record water level when compared to other storms that damaged SBRC.

Work began the next morning! Numerous repairs & upgrades to the building were completed! Countless hours of volunteer hours from members, donations of food, water, and supplies arrived, and generous monetary donations helped SBRC to "return to normal".

As we look back at all the work that had been completed, we can be very proud of all that has been accomplished! We have repaired walls, repaired/ sealed the floor in the kitchen/dining room, renovated the nursery, rebuilt the preschool office, purchased new stoves/ovens and coffee machine, rebuilt the two boilers, and so much more! A lot of time, sweat, and money has gone into the physical building and it is looking great!

There was, however, one repair that has kept us from closing out Tropical Depression Ida - replacing the main electrical feed panel. After consulting our electrician, the needed parts were ordered and then we were told that they would be delivered in 6-8 months. And so, we waited...and waited...and waited.



Well, I am SO HAPPY to report that the waiting is over!! The parts have



arrived and on Tuesday, June 20th, the final repair from Ida has been completed (I can hear all of you cheering)!! The "Ida Folder" has been closed and placed in the filing cabinet (along with the "Irene Folder").

So, with this final repair completed, I wanted to express my thanks, again, to everyone that has been involved. I am not going to list all of the names because I will inevitably forget someone, but we all know who was involved. Thank you all for what you do for SBRC!!
