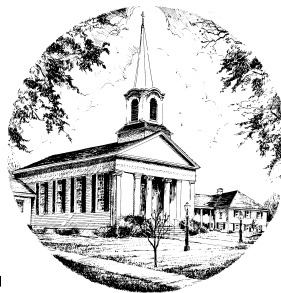

October 2023 started the collection of plastic for another Trex Bench and we have to collect 1,000 lbs over 12 months. 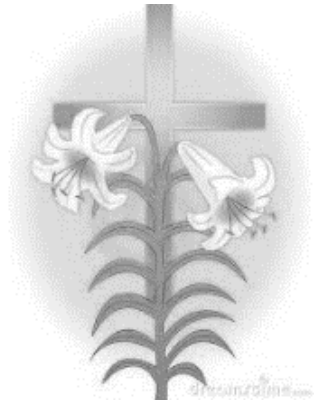

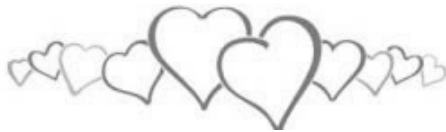
