TREASURER'S NOTES

Happy New Year! As stated in my December report, we ended 2023 \$2,174 in the black despite being in the red the last six months of the year. As it is our practice to start each new year with a zero balance in the current expense budget, I transferred the \$2,174 into a general fund, a sort of rainy-day line in the budget.

Unfortunately, January proved to be a rough month. Pledges were down, \$4,000 compared to last year. The weather was the next obstacle. First came the rains which produced widespread flooding. Thankfully, the church was spared. But then there was a



second bout of rain, followed by two snowstorms. A decision was made to cancel our January fundraiser dinner. Next, we received a bill for \$2,675 for plowing and salting. I am sad to report, we ended the month \$5,138 in the red.

But a bad start does not define who we are. If we work together, we can turn things around.

May God continue to bless SBRC and its people.


BOOK CLUB
