# TREASURER'S NOTE

The year is almost over. Where did the time go? And what a busy year it has been at SBRC.

Our 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary is only six months away, and we have been remarkably busy preparing our church for this historic celebration. A beautiful new sign has been installed. The front of the church has been powerwashed and the columns were painted. The flower beds were weeded and mulched and the shrubs pruned. With the purchase of generators, pumps and hoses, our flood defense system is now complete to face rising waters. Other projects included replacing the chapel stairs, repairing the holding tank and the pipes leading out to it, reinstalling the sidewalk by the chapel, and the repair and replacement of some parsonage windows just to name a few. Thanks to the Endowment Fund and the 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Fund, we were able to complete the above-mentioned projects.

However, we still had our regular monthly expenses to pay, which comes out of our current expense budget. Pledges were good this month. We experienced a very successful Chicken Cordon Bleu dinner, which made a profit of \$2,230. Our expenses were average for the month. We started October, \$11,105 in the red, and ended the month \$7,562 in the red. Keep up the excellent work and we can end 2024 in the black.

May God continue to bless SBRC and its Members.
