This year's Advent Study utilized the book "An Unlikely Advent" by Rachel Billups and she guided us through the lesser known characters of the familiar Christmas narrative:

Pause and think about the significance of the words and what it means to us as Christians! Let the words sink in and follow Mary's example by the pondering all these things in your heart.

A new year is approaching and a new opportunity for us to recommit ourselves to God and God's Church! The new year will bring opportunities for us to gather in worship and fellowship as well as in celebration as SBRC begins it's 175th year of Christian Work & Witness to our community.


