# TREASURER'S NOTES

December is a pivotal month for the finances of the church. For the past several years, our current expense budget has been in the red as we start the last month of the year. As I

would nervously pay our bills, including the large quarterly payments, I would pray for generous donations and hope for a miracle to get us back in the black or at least break even.



This year was a little different. We began December, \$2,043 in the black. We still made the made the large quarterly payments in addition to our regular expenses. However, the monthly donations were extraordinary. Pledges totaled over \$23,000. Despite lower than usual attendance on Christmas Eve, donations were generous. Thanks to your love and support for SBRC, we ended 2024, \$11,251 in the black.

But there is more to this story. As I recorded the donations, I realized something incredibly special. Over \$10,000 of the



donations came from people outside our membership. People who love SBRC and wanted to show their support. This is truly a special place to so many.

May God continue to bless SBRC, its members, and the community beyond our walls.



The group clipped 165 stamps to be sent to the Alliance Stamp Ministry in Fort Myers, FL who will sell them to raise money to print Sunday School materials in Spanish. Last year, 2024, they raised \$27,000. Please



keep up the good work by looking for stamps. Christmas is a good time because of all the cards. Before you recycle them, check for stamps to drop into the basket in the church office. Lets be part of the next \$27,000. No need for you to clip if you don't want to. We'll be happy to do that for you. Our gratitude goes out to all the faithful who have been contributing stamps for years. Who knows how many children you have reached for Jesus?

Also getting rare to find are coins to drop into the River Blindness container at the foot of the sanctuary steps. The poorest children in Africa can receive medicine with your coins (or bills) to prevent river blindness, or can receive glasses to see the board in school, or can have cataract surgery. Each of these can change the life of a child forever. And if you don't have coins, a bill will help too. Remember to think of the less fortunate and to bless them with your giving. Look how Jesus praised the widow's mite.
